Corrections

In the letter by Dr. N. Strang on the S.H.M.O. grade (4 January, p. 58) the sixth line was incorrect. It should have read, "if the assistant grade is allowed . . ." The last word of the letter should be "compiled."

In the article "Effect of Salbutamol on Spirometry and Blood-gas Tensions in Bronchial Asthma," by K. N. V. Palmer and M. L. Diamant, 4 January, p. 31, the dose of salbutamol should have read 200 μ g. and not 200 mg.

We regret an error in the article by Mr. E. Grattan and Mr. J. A. Hobbs, "Injuries to Hip Joint in Car Occupants" (11 January, p. 71). The final two sentences of the summary should have read, "Central fracture dislocations might be prevented, or their severity minimized, by strengthening the sides of cars and of car doors. Posterior dislocations and fractures of the acetabulum might be prevented, or their severity minimized, by improving the energy absorption characteristics of the facia panel."
