

Hospital Dental Staffing

SIR,—I am chairman of a committee which has been set up by the Secretary of State for Scotland with the following terms of reference: "To review the dental staffing structure in Scottish hospitals in the light of the principles set out in the report of the joint working party on the medical staffing structure in the hospital service; and to make recommendations about the organization of the dental staffing in each hospital region on the number, type, and distribution of posts required."

The setting up of this committee follows the agreement between the Government and the dental profession to apply the principles of the Platt report of 1961 to hospital dental staffing. The committee is now beginning its deliberations, and I am writing in the hope that you will allow me to use your columns to issue a general invitation to your readers to submit written evidence to the committee on any aspect of hospital dental staffing. All evidence submitted will receive the closest attention from the committee. Evidence should be sent to: G. R.
