

decision in the matter. Nevertheless it feels that the proposal merits very careful consideration, and it is studying the financial and other implications.

B.M.A. Scientific Charitable Trust

(135) When the Board of Science and Education was set up in 1968 to assume general responsibility for the scientific activities of the Association the original concept had been that its activities might be supported by a charitable trust in addition to funds provided by the Association. Such a trust would be used to supplement the Board's income; it would not replace the scientific budget from Association funds, which would continue to be necessary and which would be the proper source for staffing and servicing of the Board's activities, but could make available to the Board additional funds for specific projects. The trust fund would be administered by trustees, who would come primarily from the Association.

Preliminary discussions have taken place between the Chairman of the Board, the

Chief Officers of the Association and the Solicitor about a possible trust deed and the Council has expressed itself in favour of the principle of setting up a charitable trust for the Board. If the Representative Body approves the principle then the Council will proceed with the details of setting up a trust.

Recommendation: That the principle of establishing a B.M.A. Scientific Charitable Trust to support the activities of the Board of Science and Education be approved.

Health Care Teams

(136) Last session the Board of Science and Education set up a special Panel on Health Care Teams and the panel has now completed its report. This document, which does not necessarily reflect B.M.A. policy, has been produced to stimulate discussion among all who are concerned with the development of health services both in this country and overseas, and the Council hopes that it will receive wide debate. The report will be published in booklet form.
