Daisy Cooper, Liberal Democrat, St Albans mentioned **The BMJ** investigation into sexual assault in the NHS in a <u>House Of Commons</u> debate 23 May 2023: "Today, it has been revealed that there have been 35,000 cases of sexual misconduct or violence in the NHS in the past five years. Medical colleges and unions are calling for an inquiry over the shocking levels of sexual assault in the NHS. The BBC, *The Guardian, The BMJ, Byline* and others are now reporting on this issue, but we have heard little from the Government. Will you please advise me whether the Secretary of State for Health and Social Care has given any indication that the Government intends to make a statement on the issue this week? Will you further advise those of us who have been trying to force action on this issue for the best part of a year how we can secure a debate on the Floor of the House?"
