General practitioner, Worcester (b 1911; q Edinburgh University Medical School 1935; DCH, MRCGP), d 10 June 2013.

A B Milligan (“Bruce”) joined the Royal Army Medical Corps in 1939 and was stationed in North Africa and Italy throughout the war. Demobbed in 1945, he became a GP in a well established Worcester practice in 1947, where he worked until he retired in 1979. He was much liked and respected by his patients. A founder member of the Royal College of General Practitioners, he held many diverse appointments in his working

life, including factory medical officer, police surgeon, doctor to Stanbrook Abbey, and doctor to Worcester Amateur Boxing Club.

A kind generous man, he leaves a son and daughter, four grandchildren, and two great grandchildren. He will be greatly missed and fondly remembered.
