Microsomal enzymes in malnutrition as determined by plasma half life of antipyrine

We regret that an error occurred in this paper by Dr Krishnaswamy and Mr Nadamuni Naidu (26 February, p 358). In table II the plasma antipyrine concentrations at 0 hour for groups 1, 2, 3, and 4, respectively, should read: 181.7, 180.5, 183.0, and 174.5 μmol/l. The corresponding adjusted mean concentrations (column 6) should read: 1126, 101.2, 98.2, and 117.6 μ mol/l. The factor for converting μ mol/l to μ g/ml given at the foot of the table is correct.
