Corrections.—Dr. F. E. Gould (Council) spoke in the Representative Meeting's debate on the amendment of the standing orders of the Representative Body and not Dr. G. M. Gould (Haverling), as reported (*Supplement*, 17 July, p. 34). We regret the error.

We regret that the report of the Annual Representative Meeting (*Supplement*, 24 July) stated (p. 90) that Professor I. Rannie (Newcastle) spoke in support of a motion by North Staffordshire on proportional increases in pay when in fact he spoke against the motion.

Dr. R. T. Campbell (Sirling), moving an amendment to a motion by Newcastle upon Tyne on a cervical cytology service (*Supplement*, 24 July, p. 93), was reported as saying: "... no doubt all thought that there were many trivial ailments they [general practitioners] would be able to overlook for an important form of early diagnosis. However, this could be done only if they were to remain as family doctors." Dr. Campbell should have been reported as saying: "However, this could never be done if they were to remain family doctors."
