It stated that “Uruguay has recorded 1527 infections and 142 deaths [should be 42 deaths] at the time of writing, despite beginning to reopen some schools in March [should be April] and never enforcing lockdowns [specifically, no mandatory stay-at-home orders].” It also stated: “Uruguay’s first case of covid-19 was confirmed in the capital of Montevideo on 13 May [should be 13 March].” The article has now been corrected.
